# How to do a CASPER current event:

You will be responsible to do a current event every other week. They will be due on Friday, unless otherwise noted. It is YOUR responsibility to know what week you have a CE due. The class periods with a CE due will be written on the homework board all week.

**Step 1:** Choose an article from the newspaper or a legitimate internet site. The article can be no more than 2 weeks old on the day that you turn it in. The article may not be from the “News in Brief or Summary” section. You must be able to answer all CASPER questions using your article.

**Step 2:** Read your article underlining or highlighting the following information:

Cause of the event being discussed

All involved people, countries and or government

Significance of why this event is important in the world today

(this may not be written in the article, you may have to use your critical thinking skills on this)

Place the event happened, exact location (lat. and long.)

Event that took place

Reaction by all involved

**Step 3:** Read over highlighted material and make sure you have the required material to fill in at least CAPER. Fill in the chart with required information. Do not forget the title of the article, newspaper it came from date of the paper and page number.

If you do not have the Significance from the article then it is your job to determine why this event is significant to what is going on in the world or the US today. What effects could this event have on the future?

**Step 4:** Check over chart to make sure everything is filled out and it is legible. Staple the article to the CASPER sheet folded so that it is no larger than the CASPER sheet and put it into your notebook until it is time to turn it in.
