## WHAT IS JUMP START?

UPE is offering your child a new approach to summer school this year!

Instead of the traditional four-week program in June—just after school's out and with months yet to go before it starts again—we'll offer students a fun, but rigorous two-week reconnection with their literacy and math skills just before school starts again on August 18.

Our goal is to help energize and prepare students who struggle a little in school or who tend to lose skills over summer. With this new Jump Start, they will hit the ground running as the 2008-2009 school year begins!

## WHO SHOULD ENROLL IN JUMP START?

- Students who need to reach grade level in reading
- Students who are having difficulty with math
- Students with Individual Literacy Plans (ILP's)
- Students who struggle with classroom content
- Students not proficient on Colorado State Assessments

## DESCRIPTION

- Daily small-group reconnection with phonics, phonemic awareness, and decoding skills
- Guided Reading with vocabulary and spelling skills
- Daily small-group work in reading comprehension and fluency
- Daily math computer fun
