3. Updates on School Quarantines:

Our MSSD schools and schools across the region are experiencing the impact of the increased positivity rates in the county. I want to provide you with an update on the current status of our schools.

I share this information with you because we are working hard every day to keep students learning in-person. We need everyone to support us with these efforts, especially when it comes to activities outside of the school day. The number one need is that no one comes to school or work if ill or not feeling well. Also, do not come to school or work if you have been in close contact with:


- A person who has a confirmed COVID-19 result or
- A person who has been under quarantine for possible exposure to COVID-19 and is symptomatic. Right now, 52% of our staff are currently quarantined for various reasons. Of the total, 62% of staff are a result of the quarantine at MSES. As we move forward, we will continue to assess the instructional models that are sustainable with our current impact to a large number of staff needing to be quarantined. We have teachers covering other teacher's classes. We have district staff teaching classes. We have others filling in and support colleagues who are quarantined. Please note...There may be circumstances that require us to move to remote learning if our ability to provide staffing is not possible. We know this is not ideal or easy.



4. Fuel ED Updates:

We know that there have been questions about the continuation of an online option for students the second semester. We will continue to offer Fuel ED as an online option.

The deadline to communicate interest for **current** Fuel ED students to continue participating in Fuel ED for the second semester is Monday, November 9. A <u>2nd reminder</u> for those families who have not yet responded will be sent later today by Kolleen Johnson.

This semester we have several students who experienced success. We also know that Fuel ED was a challenging platform for many students due to the nature of the amount of work required, late arrival of materials, mode of online instruction, and potential for increased feelings of isolation. For those reasons:

- Students who did not complete or pass a course may not be granted the opportunity to participate in Fuel ED.
- If this is the case, someone from the child's school will be speaking directly with the parent and student.
- The school team will communicate the recommendation to the school's principal in partnership with the parent of the child.

This will allow current Fuel ED students to be registered by December 4 (pending school and parent conversations)

For high school classes, we want to remind you that any student who does not pass a course needed for graduation will need to retake the course. The students will not receive credit on their official high school transcript, and the grade earned in Fuel ED will be put onto their transcript. The district will not cover the cost to re-take the course if the credit recovery is sought via FuelED. In some situations, the student will have the option to re-take the course in-person during a different semester.

5. Inclement Weather Day/Snow Day During COVID Update (more specific information will be shared by each school)

E-Connect/Learning Day

- Staff will start two-hours later than a building's normal schedule.
- Neither students nor staff report in-person to school/work.
- All students will participate in one synchronous/online session (see school schedule). During this time, students
 will have a connection with teachers and students. The time will be used to set a goal and intention for the day
 (e.g., make-up missed assignments, accelerate new learning). The check-in will also include social-emotional
 supports.
- Counselor/Social Worker has an identified time to meet with students (Office Hours).
- Secondary teachers will have a scheduled office hour to support students individually.
